## Opening of the Senate Room

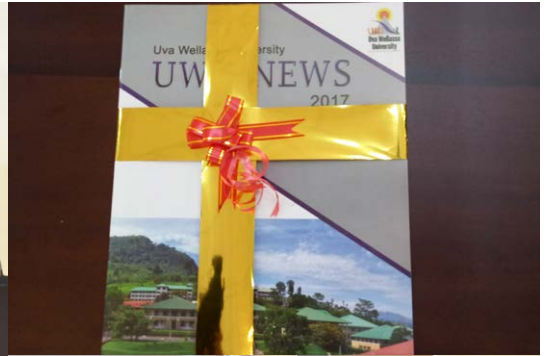

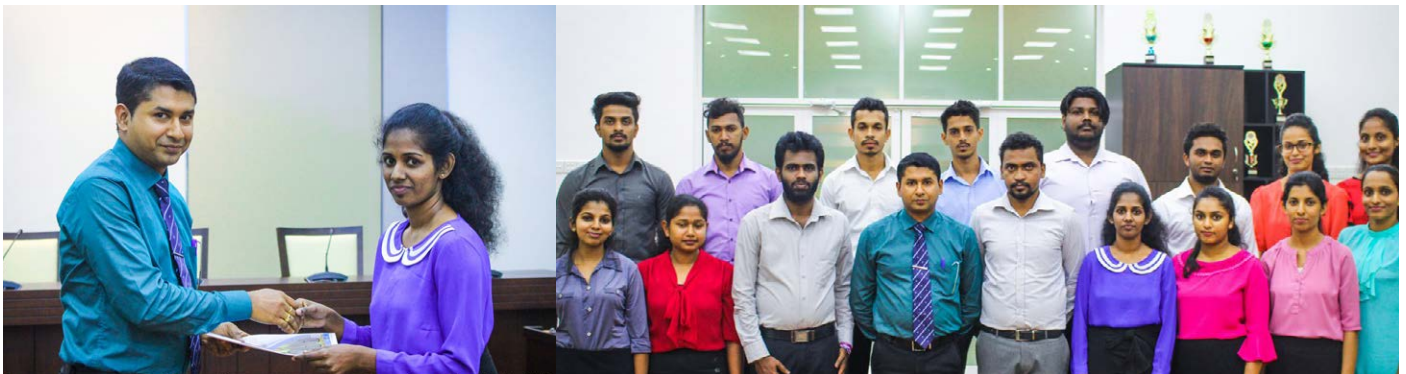

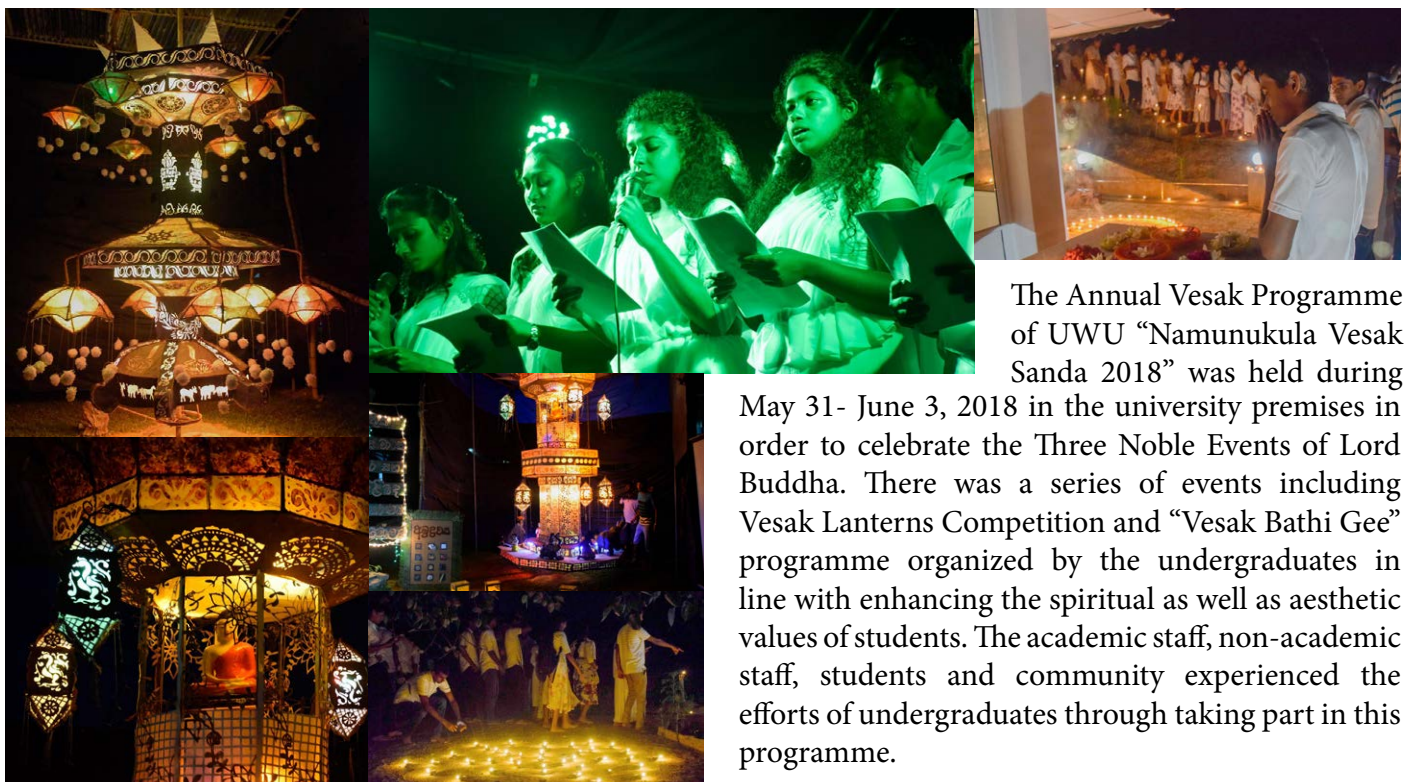
# Co-existence within Cultures, Traditions, Religions and Festivities

### Research Grant Awarded

Prof. EPSK Ediriweera, Department of Science & Technology, UWU has been awarded a research grant (LKR 18 million) to conduct a research at Sinharaja Forest Dynamics Plot. The UWU and Smithsonian Tropical Research Institute-USA signed an agreement on November 22, 2017. The Forest Global Earth Observatory (ForestGEO), previously known as Center for Tropical Forest Science (CTFS) is a global network of forest research sites and scientists dedicated to the study of tropical and temperate forest function and diversity. The multi-institutional network comprises over 60 forest research plots across the America, Africa, Asia, and Europe, with a strong focus on tropical regions. CTFS-ForestGEO monitors the growth and survival of approximately 6 million trees and 10,000 species (<https://forestgeo.si.edu/>).

The Sinharaja Forest Dynamics Site was founded in 1993 by Prof. C.V.S. Gunatilleke and Prof. I.A.U.N. Gunatilleke of the University of Peradeniya, the Department of Forests, Sri Lanka and Forest GEO.
